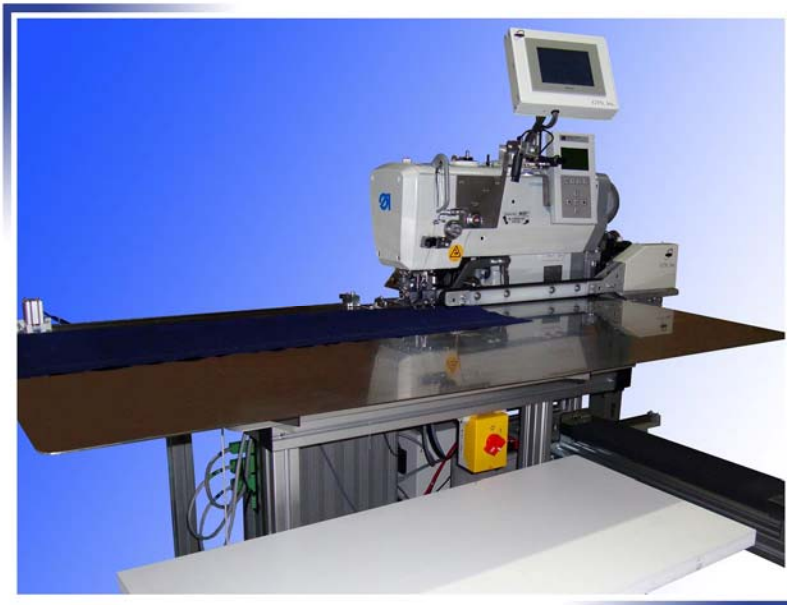

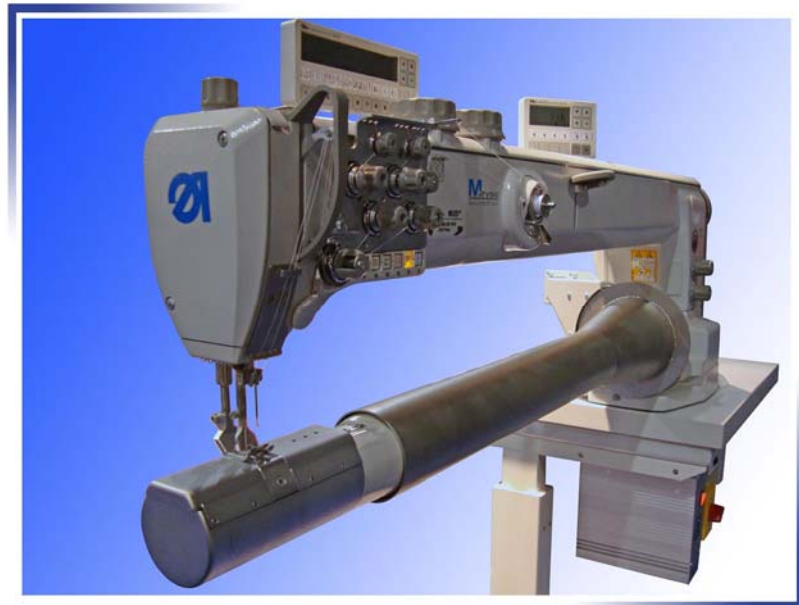

The integrated **large hooks (XL hooks) hold more bobbin thread** than conventional hooks. Using pre-wound bobbins will further increase this number significantly!

Together with the automatic thread trimmers, the effective running time of the machine will manifold due to much **less consumption of bobbin thread, hence less downtime for bobbin change!**

Focusing on an ergonomic workplace, the optional, **step motor driven revolving drum** reliefs the operator from manually pushing the sewing material around the cylinder arm.

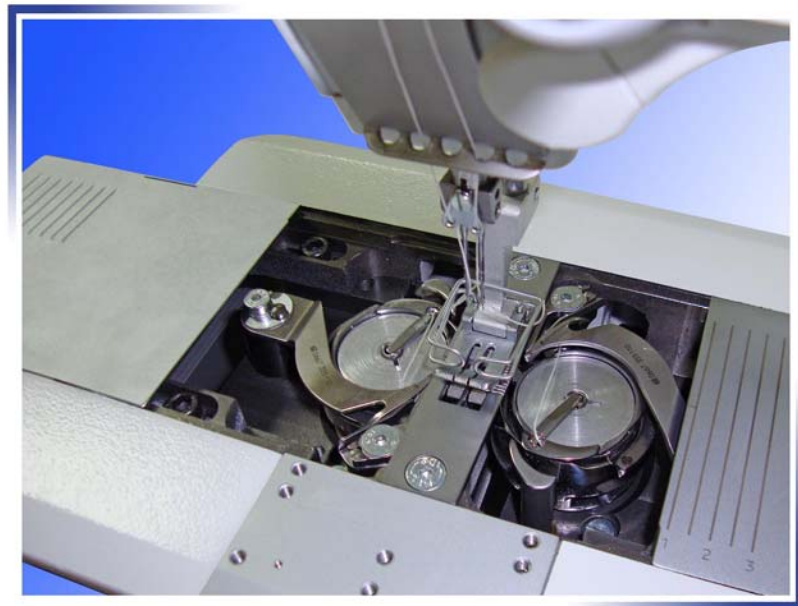
Double Needle, Needle Feed Machine



Catching up on the latest trend in the jeans industry we now offer a **heavy duty double needle, needle feed machine** out of our successful M-Type platform for hemming pockets.

The **extra large hooks (XXL hooks) with 70% higher bobbin thread capacity** offer an unparalleled running time of the machine*. To even further enhance, we recommend the use of pre-wound bobbins.

An additional benefit of the Dürkopp Adler 827-290040 machine is the ability to use **very heavy threads (up to Nm10/3 or Tex300)** and go for a **stitch length of up to 12mm (1/2")**. Both has been extensively used for high fashion jeans lately.



However it is designed for medium to heavy duty sewing operations **the 827-290040**

offers a sewing speed of up to 4,000 stitches per minute, thus making it a valuable asset in your production line.

An **optional pneumatic foot lift kit** will further facilitate handling of the machine.

A fully automatic version (827-290342) will be available shortly and offers automatic thread trimming, foot lift and back tack as well as a quick stroke adjustment and a second stitch length.
